The latest Conference Program and Social Activities Program will be included in the delegate folder.

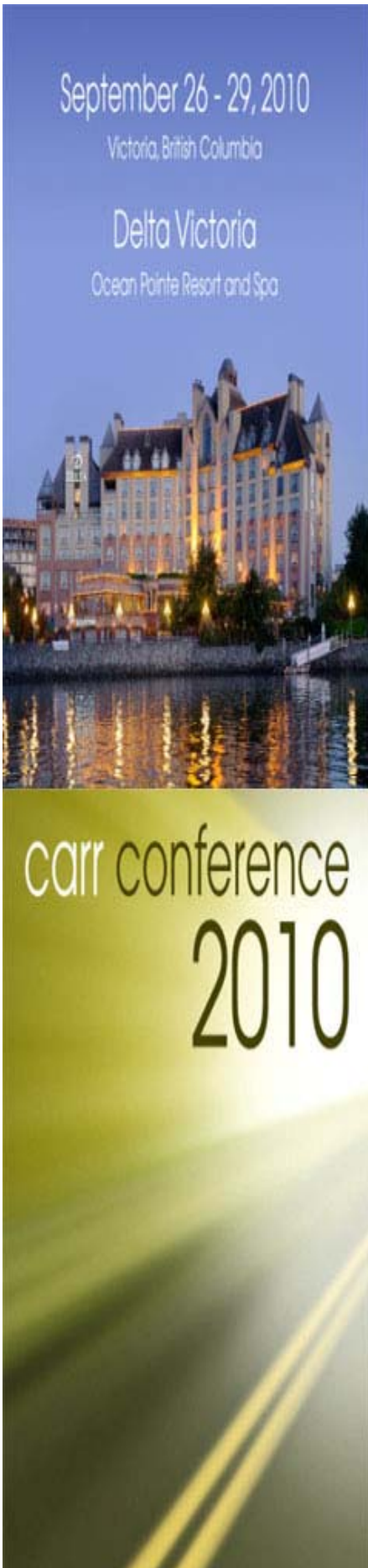
Transportation

If you are travelling to Victoria by air, the Victoria International Airport (YYJ) is approximately 30 minutes from the venue. Regular float plane service to Victoria's downtown Inner Harbour is available from Vancouver. See Harbour Air Seaplanes for more details at www.harbourair.ca. Victoria Harbour is about a 5 minute drive from the venue. Taxis are readily available.

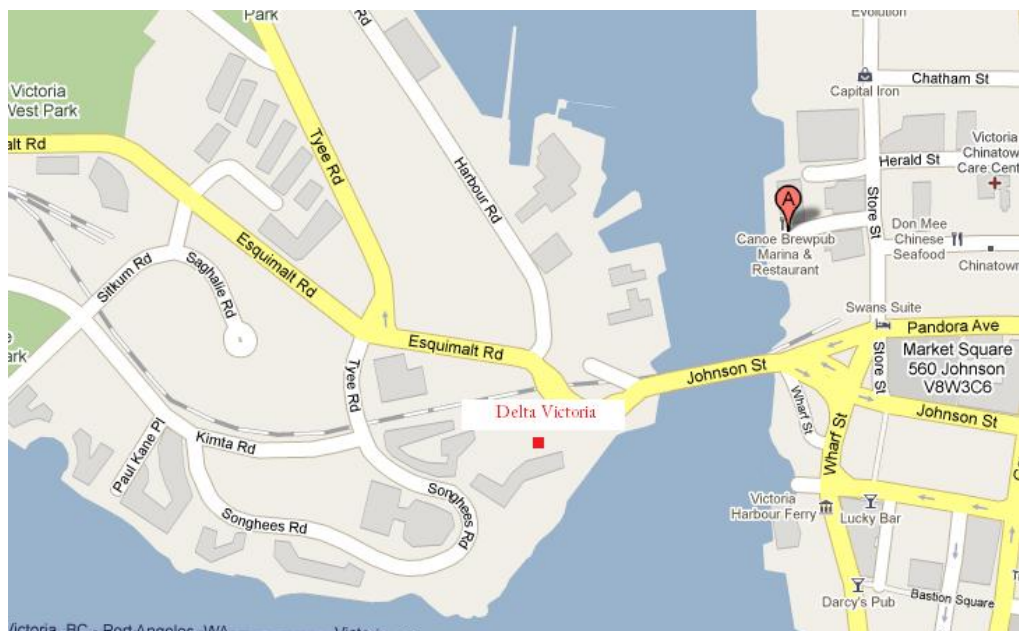

Ghostly Walks run every night at 7:30 pm. during the conference. 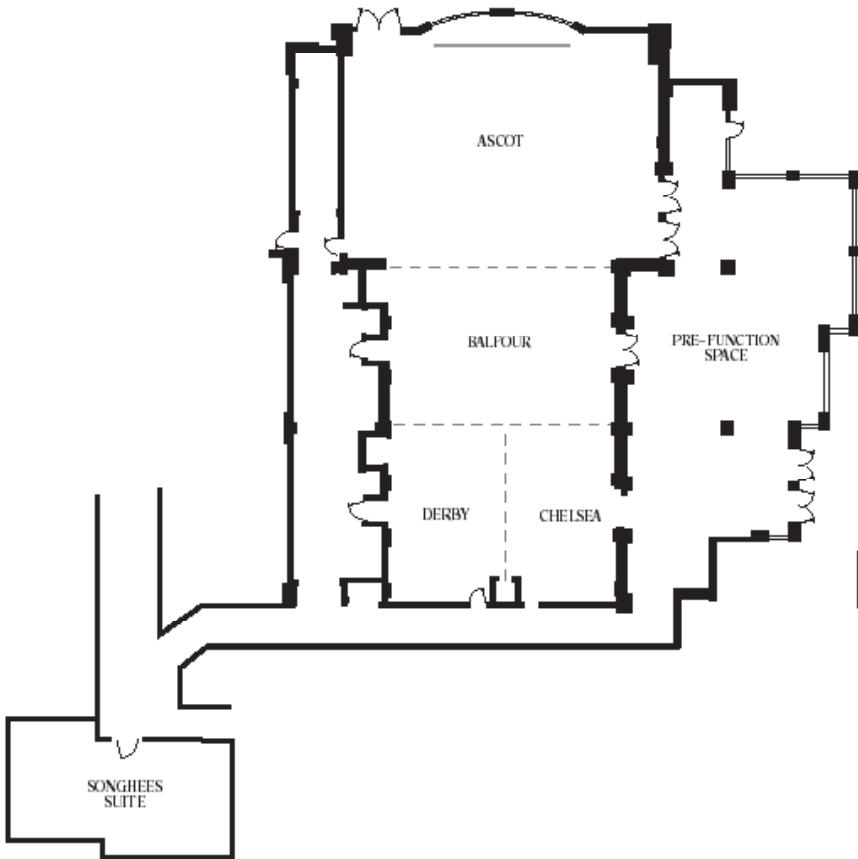

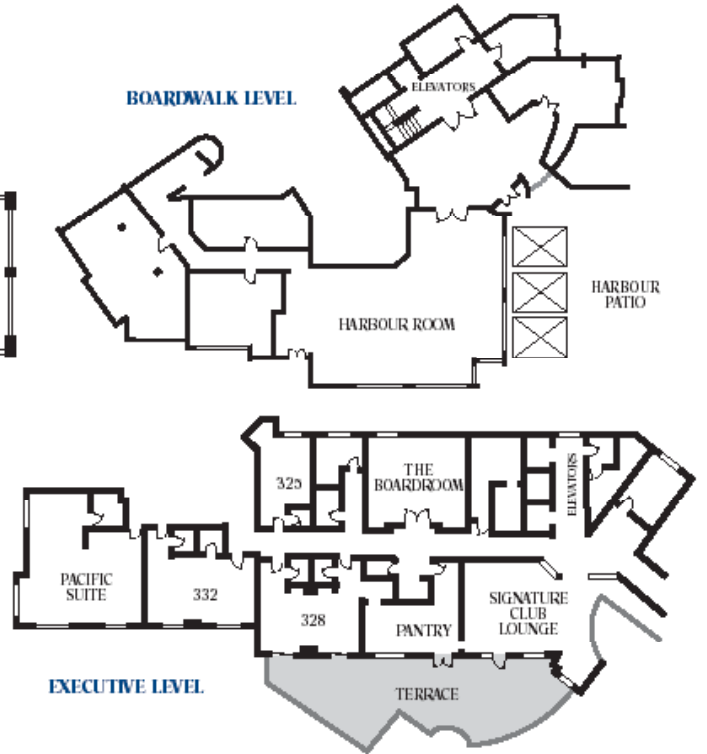
